Polar Bear Promise Posters

- Paper or Posters
- Markers/crayons
- Craft materials (fabric scraps, aluminum foil, yarn, balloons, leaves, etc.)
- Scissors
- Glue

How To:

Talk to the students about how our daily lives can affect the environment. Divide the class into small groups and have them decide what they can do to be less wasteful. Remind them that everything they do to recycle and conserve energy resources helps.

Examples:

- Students can reduce, reuse, and recycle
- Taking showers instead of baths and turning the water off when they are brushing their teeth helps conserve water.
- Unplugging things that aren't in use and turning off lights helps reduce CO2.

Give each group a poster and have them write their ideas down and draw pictures showing how they are going to help the environment. Encourage them to use different craft materials to be creative.

Ask each group to present their posters to the whole class. When each group is done, put them up around the classroom as a reminder to the students.
